## All that glitters... Silver in early medieval coinage

Though silver played a very minor role in the coinage of the later Roman and early Byzantine Empires, it was the dominant metal in the coinage of the Sasanian Empire to the East. The talk will investigate the phases and circumstances whereby silver became the exclusive metal of medieval European coinage, while the monetary systems of Byzantium and Islam remained tri-metallic.
